

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals will be received by the Town of Cary, to the attention of Ms. Alexandra Jones, at the office of the Engineering Department, 2nd Floor, 316 North Academy Street, Cary, North Carolina until Tuesday, December 6, 2011 at 3:00 p.m. and thereafter immediately opened and read publicly at Engineering Department Conference Room 21275, at the same address, for the furnishing of materials, labor, and equipment for the construction of:

Contract 2– Solids Treatment Facility,
Western Wake Regional Water Reclamation Facility
Town of Cary Project No. SW1123

Contract 2 of the 18 MGD Western Wake Regional Water Reclamation Facility project consists of constructing the solids handling processes for the new Western Wake Regional Water Reclamation Facility in Apex, North Carolina. The Bid Proposal (Section 00300) provides for the Bidder to submit bids for Contract 2.

The Town of Cary is advertising Contract 2, consisting of Plans, Technical Specifications and Contract Documents. Contract 2 is defined as follows:

Contract 2 –Engineer: Brown and Caldwell – Consists of Solids Treatment Facilities, including liquid sludge loading facilities, scum digester, belt filter press dewatering, dewatered biosolids cake pumping and storage, polymer storage and feed system, biosolids cake receiving, biosolids dryers, dried biosolids storage silos, odor control facilities and solids handling building as shown on the Contract 2 Drawings and included in the Contract 2 Technical Specifications.

Hard copies of Plans, Specifications and Contract documents may be reviewed at the office of the Director of Engineering, Cary Town Hall, and the office of the Engineer. A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held for Contract 2 on November 8th, at 2:00 p.m. at the office of the Town of Cary Engineering Department, 316 North Academy Street, Cary, North Carolina. **Attendance at the pre-bid conference is mandatory for those potential Bidders that plan to submit a Bid.**

Contractors offering a proposal on this project must be licensed to do the specified type of contracting in the State of North Carolina. A Town of Cary Privilege License in accordance with North Carolina General Statutes is required for award of the project. All bids must include a non-collusive affidavit.

The proposal shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in the amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the higher bid of Contract 2, as shown in the Bid Proposal, and subject to the conditions provided in the Instruction to Bidders.

The Town of Cary reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.
